Thought-Provoking Questions

The purpose of the questions is to facilitate a deeper understanding of the Bible, this Bible study topic, and ourselves. The questions may be answered by each reader; or used by a Bible study group leader or church pastor. The following questions should be answered or discussed after reading "4 Types of Death 1 Source of Life."

There are two types of questions: lesson and opinion. Lesson questions (preceded by a number) are provided answers on the next page. Opinion questions (preceded by an ①) are designed to enhance learning via the determination of opinions and/or discovering how the lesson content illuminates our personal lives. As such, no answers are provided.

1. Match (Enter the letter into the left column that corresponds to the type of death.)

2. Match (Enter the letter into the left column that corresponds to the type of death.)

	Sinful Nature	D	An empty house.
