



Bible Study Thought-Provoking Questions

The purpose of the questions is to facilitate a deeper understanding of the Bible, this Bible study topic, and ourselves. The questions may be answered by each reader, or used by a Bible study group leader, or church pastor. The questions should be answered or discussed after reading the lesson. In addition, the questions are designed to enhance learning via the determination of personal opinions and discovering how the lesson content relates to our personal lives. As such, no answers are provided.

Questions

- ① Which of the 7 Revelation blessings do you think is most important?
- ① Why do you think God added these 7 blessings to Revelation? What purpose do they provide?
- ① The lesson described how we emotionally respond to the experience of flying in airplane that is severely buffeted by air turbulence. Identify at least 3 ways this analogy correlates to the last days.
- ① Jesus spoke to the 7 churches (Rev. 2 & 3). He identified something within each church that requires improvement.
 - Were you surprised to learn of the degree of specific knowledge Jesus had of each church?
 - Can you identify an example of how His words—written almost 2,000 years ago—are relatable to today?
 - Which one speaks to your heart the most?
- ① The Bible states people will be murdered for their faith because they did not worship the beast and did not receive his mark. Consider where our “global society” is today and identify aspects that will change for this to occur.
- ① **“Blessed is he who watches, and keeps his garments, lest he walk naked and they see his shame.”** Rev. 16:15
 - What does it mean to watch?
 - What and where would you look?
 - What does it mean to keep your garments?
 - What do the words “walk naked” and “shame” mean?
- ① Why do you think the Bible does not state the specific time when Jesus will return?
- ① The lesson states that there is nothing we can do to change the inevitable direction this world is headed. Do you agree or disagree?
- ① If someone was interested in the lesson and they asked you to provide a short summary...what would you say?
- ① Is there anything new you have learned from this lesson?
