



## Bible Study Thought-Provoking Questions

The purpose of the questions is to facilitate a deeper understanding of the Bible, this Bible study topic, and ourselves. The questions may be answered by each reader, or used by a Bible study group leader, or church pastor. The questions should be answered or discussed after reading “Open Your Spiritual Eyes.” In addition, the questions are designed to enhance learning via the determination of personal opinions and/or discovering how the lesson content relates to our personal lives. As such, no answers are provided.

### Questions

- ① Identify at least 3 reasons why it is important for Christians to open their spiritual eyes.
- ① The lesson compared the spiritual realm to the production of a movie. From a spiritual perspective:
  - How would you define the messaging that is depicted in the majority of movies today?
  - Does this messaging reveal “behind the scenes” efforts to reinforce sin and darkness?
  - Can you identify messaging content in other communication mediums that reinforce sin and darkness?
- ① The lesson states that we are all spiritually blind from birth. Do you agree or disagree?
- ① The lesson lists 4 things we can do to facilitate the opening of our spiritual eyes.
  - Which do you think is most important?
  - Which one should you increase in your daily walk with Jesus?
- ① The lesson listed examples of visual discomfort that may be experienced as our spiritual eyes are opened.
  - Have you experienced any of these examples?
  - If yes, how did you respond?
- ① Why is it important to consider the attitude of our heart when we encounter someone who is bound by sin?
  - Which attitudes of our heart reflects Jesus in this situation?
  - Which attitudes of our heart are potentially harmful in this situation?
- ① Is there a correlation between spiritual insight and Godly wisdom? If yes, can you identify examples?
- ① Did you learn anything new from this lesson?
