Thought-Provoking Questions

The purpose of the questions is to facilitate a deeper understanding of the Bible, this Bible study topic, and ourselves. The questions may be answered by each reader, or used by a Bible study group leader, or church pastor. The questions should be answered or discussed after reading, "Are You Missing A Piece of the Puzzle." In addition, the questions are designed to enhance learning via the determination of personal opinions and/or discovering how the lesson content relates to our personal lives. As such, no answers are provided.

Questions

- ① The lesson states we have a spiritual void within us.
 - How would you describe this void?
 - What are indicators of the void's existence?
- ① The lesson explains how sin is used as an attempt to fill the spiritual void within us. Can you identify examples?
- ① The lesson states that Satan uses an assortment of delusional lies that promotes sin as a means to fill the emptiness within.
 - Can you identify examples of his tactics?
 - How does someone rationalize their acceptance of sin? Is this also a lie?
- ① How would you describe the heart and soul of someone who hungers and thirsts for righteousness?
- ① Explain the spiritual allegory Jesus declared in Revelation 3:20:
